

Secondary School KIT LIST – Please give to students

<p>Bedding (unless your school group has booked Leeson House bedding)</p> <p><i>1 x single sheet and 1 x Duvet cover, plus pillowcases</i> <u>NO SLEEPING BAGS please</u></p>
<p><i>A pair of clean, indoor shoes. Slippers could be used. For safety reasons, no novelty slippers or flip flops!</i></p>
<p><i>Plastic bin liner for wet or dirty clothes</i></p>
<p><i>Clean casual clothes for indoor wear</i></p>
<p><i>Towel, wash kit, nightwear. No aerosols to be used in bedrooms although they can be used in the main bathrooms</i></p>
<p>Field Work Kit List</p>
<p>Waterproof coat and if possible, waterproof trousers</p>
<p><i>Walking boots, or strong low-heeled shoes or outdoor trainers</i></p>
<p><i>Old jeans, joggers, etc (2 pairs or more), shorts in summer</i></p>
<p><i>Warm fleece jumper/jacket in the colder months</i></p>
<p><i>Wellington boots – essential for those studying rivers and rock pools</i></p>
<p><i>Sunhat and protective sun-screening lotion in summer</i></p>
<p><i>2 sweaters/sweatshirts (extra warm, preferably fleecy, in winter)</i></p>
<p><i>Several pairs of socks, at least one thick pair</i></p>
<p><i>During the colder times of the year, the following will provide extra layers for warmth: extra jumpers or T-shirts (preferably long-sleeved), leggings, or similar</i></p>

<p>Equipment</p>
<p>Small day rucksack and a suitable container for packed lunch – both items clearly labelled with the student's name</p>
<p>Plastic watertight bottle, marked with owner's name for the packed lunch drink as we do not provide bottles</p>
<p>Usual stationary for classroom lessons, a scientific calculator would be useful for statistics sessions</p>
<p>Laptop – you're welcome to bring and use them (at owners' risk). However, we do have several desktop computers</p>
