2	Roads	Environment: Narrow road out of Acton towards Langton Road	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Keep group in single file • Reflective waistcoats to be worn
3	Disturbance to residents	People: noise and invasion of privacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask pupils to keep noise levels down and to respect privacy of residents
